CEASE AND DESIST ORDER
BY STIPULATION

The Iowa Architectural Examining Board ("Board") and Clare Cardinal-Pett ("Cardinal-Pett") stipulate to the following Cease and Desist Order pursuant to Iowa Code § 544A.15 (1997):

1. Cardinal-Pett is an associate professor of architecture at Iowa State University and referred to herself as an "architect" in an article she authored in the Des Moines Register on April 19, 1997 entitled "New Grid on the Block."

2. Cardinal-Pett is not currently registered as an architect in Iowa under Iowa Code chapter 544A (1997).

3. The Board is authorized by Iowa Code section 544A.20 to seek an injunction in district court enjoining any person who is not legally authorized to practice architecture in Iowa from engaging in such practice or offering to engage in such practice. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 544A.15, it is unlawful for a person to engage in or offer to engage in the practice of architecture in this state or use in connection with the person's name the title "architect", "registered architect", "architectural designer", or imply that the person provides or offers to provide professional architectural services, or to otherwise assume, use, or advertise any title, word, figure,

sign, card, advertisement, or other symbol or description tending to convey the impression that the person is an architect or is engaged in the practice of architecture unless the person is qualified by registration as provided by this chapter. The board is also authorized by Iowa Code section 544A.15 to impose a civil penalty upon a nonlicensee for the same violations.

4. The Board and Cardinal-Pett have agreed to informally resolve the pending complaint concerning Cardinal-Pett's article. The article, authored by Cardinal-Pett states, "As an architect, I am hard-pressed to label this new building 'different' unless, perhaps, I turn to something about the building that is somewhat invisible, its construction."


5. Cardinal-Pett agrees that she will not in the future engage in the practice of architecture in Iowa, as defined in Iowa Code section 544A.16A(9), or represent to the public any ability to do so without becoming registered as an architect in Iowa. Cardinal-Pett agrees to either become registered or refrain from referring to herself as an "architect" in Iowa.

6. In the event this Stipulation is violated, it may be used as evidence in a subsequent enforcement action before the Board or in district court.


7. This Stipulation is a public record pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 22.
