Now on the 24th day of January 1975, the Iowa Board of Accountancy, Leo E. Burger, Chairman, Harry B. Carlson, Secretary-Treasurer, and Roger R. Cloutier, Member, being present and constituting the full board, having heard and taken testimony on November 22, 1974 finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. That John Stephen Stoko on March 4, 1974 entered a plea of guilty to the charge of Larceny in the Iowa District Court for Leon County.
2. That larceny is a felony under Iowa Code Section 709.1 (1973).
3. That John Stephen Stoko was served a notice of a hearing to be held on November 22, 1974, before the Iowa Board of Accountancy but was not present at the hearing.

ORDER

Now on the 24th day of January 1975, the matter of C.P.A. Certificate No. 827 issued to John Stephen Stoko, having been heard on November 22, 1974, the Iowa Board of Accountancy finds that under Section 116.14 of the Code of Iowa, John Stephen Stoko was guilty of a felony.

1. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that C.P.A. Certificate No. 827 issued to John Stephen Stoko is hereby revoked under Section 116.14 of the Code of Iowa.
2. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that John Stephen Stoko shall no longer be authorized to practice accountancy in the State of Iowa.
3. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that John Stephen Stoko shall surrender his C.P.A. Certificate No. 827 to the Iowa Board of Accountancy within 10 days after receiving a copy of this order.
